

# Humble Yourselves: A Lenten Reflection on 1 Peter 5:6-7

"Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, so that He may exalt you in due time. Cast all your anxiety on Him, because he cares for you."

I recently reflected on how the Holy Spirit has humbled me early on in this Lenten season; helped me get out of my own head (out of my own way) and let Him work through me; helped me to realize not all my relationships are as symbiotic as God would like them to be.

There are times when we need to be humbled in order to learn and grow; believe me, this isn't the first time I have been humbled by God. For me, it took being submissive to God in order to live into my baptism. It took a willingness to let go of control and hand all my anxieties over to Him.

The Holy Spirit empowers us all if we are willing to submit ourselves to Him and find humbleness in our relationship with God. This is my prayer for all of you this Lenten season; that you submit yourselves to God; humble yourselves before our Creator; and grow into a "right relationship with God by faith." Amen.


