


The Value of Continuing Education

In the first seven days of May, I will complete two separate continuing education efforts. The first, is my required First Call Theological Education (FCTE). Every pastor and deacon must complete three years of FCTE immediately following their graduation from seminary, ordination, and beginning their first call. This requirement is designed to help clergy starting out in professional ministry to grow their network of colleagues and give them support. Seminary cannot teach everything someone needs to be successful in ministry, so FCTE is also designed to further one's knowledge to help them succeed.

My second continuing education effort is called The Moses Project, which I have been part of since August 2023. This opportunity lasts 10 months and is also designed to expand a clergyperson's network of colleagues and grow their knowledge on various topics pertaining to ministry. This effort is carried out through Grandview University in Des Moines and involves in person gatherings, modules of learning, zoom meetings both small group and one on one, and large group exemplar zoom meetings.

I have found both of these continuing education efforts to be valuable. Whatever field you are in, I would encourage you to seek out continuing education opportunities to further your skills and set you up for success in your chosen vocation.






